TO BE ELIGIBLE YOU NEED TO...

- Be enrolled as a **domestic or international student**, at one of Study Geelong's post secondary school education institutions OR have completed your study no more than 6 months ago, be living in Geelong and be on a post study work rights visa (or a bridging visa whilst you transfer between these visas). - Be 18 years old or over and have a valid visa if you are an international student
- Commit to an average 5 hours per month of activity organised by Study Geelong (this may vary from month to month)
- Publish on Study Geelong's social media channels (Facebook and Instagram) and write/video 2 blogs for the website
- Have good organisation and time management skills; be reliable and punctual
- Be able to work independently as well as part of a team



NATURE OF THE ROLE

The Study Geelong Student Ambassador is an honorary and voluntary position and no pay will be offered to program participants. However, you will receive free training and networking opportunities.

HOW TO APPLY

1. Submit a resume (CV) of no more than two pages with two referees.
2. Submit a video of no more than 60 seconds as to why you would make a great Study Geelong Student Ambassador.

- Applications are open now and **close 5pm, Monday 15 November, 2021.**
- If you are shortlisted you **must** be available to attend an online interview on 24th/25th November.
- Successful candidates **must** attend an induction session on Monday, 13 December, 10am - 12pm.
- Further training will be provided in January 2022.
- Successful candidates **must** apply for a Volunteer Working With Children Card.
- Successful candidates **must** be fully vaccinated by 13 December 2021 or provide a medical exemption.
